## **Operating Instructions for Digital Charging Locker**

Note: Before using the product, please read the instructions carefully!

Do not attempt to disassemble this product. If the product does not work properly, please call our Customer Service Department at 1-844-221-3393.

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### **Features**

- 1. Embedded with Android 5.1.1 smart operating system and unique UI design, bringing you a more convenient operation and better visual experience.
- 2. Support USB mouse and keyboard, realizing easy manipulation like a computer. Using a mouse for set up is recommended.
- 3. Built-in Wi-Fi module, high capacity memory and high capacity cache, making it smoother to watch 1080P HD movies and play big games.
- 4. High-quality LCD screen as the display, no flicker, low radiation, greatly reducing eye fatigue, eye protection, high brightness, high contrast, and wide viewing angle; ultra-fast response time greatly reduces ghosting of fast moving images.
- 5. Progressive image processing and industry-leading motion compensation technology improve the flickering and blurring in the edges of motion picture.
- 6. Dynamic contrast technology can significantly improve the clarity and contrast of various screens.
- 7. Multi-channel USB interfaces, supporting HD media streaming.
- 8. 9 Charging Lockers, each locker has 1 Type-C, 1 lightning & 1 micro USB cable covering all phone types.

### **Safety Warnings and Precautions**

Thank you for purchasing the high-performance multi-functional Digital Charging Kiosk from Displays2go. We have considered the factors to ensure personal safety in product design and have tested rigorously at the factory. However, improper installation and use may result in electric shock and fire.

In order to safely use, maximize performance of the unit and extend the life of the product, please read and follow all instructions carefully before using the product.

Keep the instructions for future reference.

We strongly recommend using a surge protector, or a power strip with internal circuit breaker to prevent damages to the digital charging locker.

#### If any of the following occurs:

- Power outage or instable voltage.
- Abnormal sound or smell from the unit.
- AC power cord is damaged.
- Digital charging locker is damaged due to drop, knock or impact.
- Any liquid or foreign matters fall into the enclosure.



Turn off the digital charging locker immediately, pull out the plug from the power outlet, and ask the authorized personnel for maintenance timely.

If coal gas or other flammable gas leaks, do not pull out the plug of the LCD digital charging locker or other electrical appliances; instead, turn off the gas valve immediately, and open the doors and windows quickly.

- Cut off the power supply before connecting or disconnecting any cables.
- Do not place the digital charging locker on any instable positions, or else it may be damaged or cause fire.
- Do not place the digital charging locker in the positions such as:
  - 1. The environment subject to direct strong sunlight, moisture, extreme temperature or too much dust;
  - 2. The environment with flammable or explosive materials;
  - 3. The environment with flammable or corrosive gases;
- Do not use damaged or inappropriate power outlets, and ensure that the plugs and outlets contact properly.
- Do not let dust or metal deposits adhere to the plugs and outlets.
- Do not damage the power cords:
  - 1. Do not modify the power cords;
  - 2. Do not place heavy objects on the power cords;
  - 3. Keep the power cords away from heat source;
  - 4. Do not pull the cord to remove the plug.
- Do not connect too many plugs to one outlet in parallel, or else it may cause fire due to excessive power consumption.
- Do not approach the digital charging locker with open flame (e.g. a lighted candle), or else it may cause electric shock or fire.
- Do not put any sharp objects, metal or liquid into the vents or let them touch the signal terminals to avoid short circuit, product damage, and electric shock.
- The openings in the enclosure are designed for ventilation and cooling, to ensure long time reliable running of components inside the enclosure and prevent overheating. Do not block the openings when placing the unit.
- Do not charge more than 1 phone in a compartment.
- Do not touch the plugs with wet fingers, or else it will cause electric shock.
- Do not use the digital charging locker in stormy weather, especially when there is lightning; instead, please disconnect the power and antenna plugs to avoid lightning strike.
- Do not disassemble the digital charging locker without permission, or else it may cause electric shock or fire. Please ask qualified technician for repair.



- Do not let children climb onto the digital charging locker.
- Keep the small parts away from children to prevent them from swallowing.
- If the digital charging locker won't be used for a long time, turn it off and pull out the power plug.
- To adjust the position of the digital charging locker, please disconnect all power cords and move slowly to avoid tip over.
- Do not scratch or knock the LCD with hard object, or twist and squeeze the LCD.
- Do not turn on the unit immediately when it is moved from a place with low temperature to high temperature, or else it will cause condensation and malfunction.
- Before cleaning the digital charging locker, please pull out the power plug; wipe with soft cloth; do
  not use industrial chemicals; prevent foreign matters from entering the machine. Improper cleaning
  (such as cleaning solution, water) may damage the product, erase the printed information, and even
  cause damage of the components if fluid flows in, resulting in machine failure.
- If the unit displays the same screen for a long time or the moving picture has fixed text or icon, it will leave ghosting on the screen and won't disappear when the unit is turned off; it is normal and isn't covered by the warranty.
- The power of the digital charging locker can be cut off by pulling out the plug.
- If the LCD screen ruptures and the liquid splashes on the skin, please rinse for 15 minutes with clean water immediately, and consult your doctor.
- Use the digital charging locker properly: Use in proper lighting conditions; insufficient lighting or long time watching will impair your eyesight.
- When the plug or coupler is used as disconnection device, it should be easy to operate the device.
- Insert the plug into the outlet properly, or else it may cause sparks and fire.
- The technical specifications printed herein and on the packaging are subject to change without prior notice. The Manual may be slightly different from actual operation, and the latter is applicable.




### Interfaces

### **Steps for Assembly**

- 1. Open the top cover as shown in Fig. 2;
- 2. Remove EPE on both sides of the box as shown in Fig. 3;
- 3. Take out the base from the package as shown in Fig. 4;
- 4. Carefully lift out the unit as shown in Fig. 5 and place it on the shipping box (avoid scratching) (Fig. 6);
- 5. Assemble the base and the unit with dedicated screws using hex socket wrench as shown in Fig. 6.





### **Steps for Assembly with Casters**


1. To use this product as a mobile unit, install 4 casters to the metal base by threading them into the holes on the bottom of the base. Tighten all casters with a 14mm wrench.



2. Connect the base and the digital charging locker with provided screws. Tighten all screws with an Allen wrench.



3. The assembly is finished:



### Installing batteries for the remote control:

Remove the battery cover and insert two AAA batteries (1.5V). Ensure that the battery polarity matches the "+"/"-" marks in the battery compartment of the remote control.

#### Precautions for using the remote control:

- Aim the remote control at the receiver window. Do not place any object between the remote control and the receiver window to avoid interference with the normal operation.
- Keep the remote control away from violent vibration. In addition, do not set or place the remote control in direct sunlight, or else the remote control may be deformed by heat.
- The remote control may be invalid when the receiver window of the unit is in direct sunlight or strong lighting; in this case, please adjust the angle of the lighting or the unit or approach the receiver window to use it.
- The distance of remote control will be shortened if the battery voltage is insufficient; in this case, please
  replace with new batteries; if the remote control won't be used for a long time or the batteries are run out,
  please take out the batteries to avoid corrosion due to battery leakage, which will damage the remote control.
- Do not use batteries of different types or mix new batteries with old ones. Always replace the batteries in pairs.
- Do not put the batteries in fire, or charge or disassemble them, or charge, short circuit, disassemble, heat or burn used batteries. Please dispose of waste batteries in accordance with local environmental regulations. Do not expose the batteries in overheated environments such as sunlight and fire.

### Power on/Standby

Insert the power plug into the outlet. If the Digital charging locker has the switch button "I", turn it on; if you press the switch button "O", the Digital charging locker enters standby state.

In power on state, enter "System Assistant" and press the " () " button on the remote control, and the Digital charging locker enters standby state.

### **How to Upload Media Files:**

Step 1: Open the Android launcher screen and click the explorer app






Step 2: Go to the USB storage menu click the USB storage button



Step 3: At the USB storage menu select Multi and then highlight the media files which you want to copy to the media folder. Click the Editor button, the pop menu will show then click the Copy







Step 4: Click HOME button and go to the NAND FLASH menu.






Select MediaFolder and then open the Images Folder.





Step 5: At the images folder click the edit button at the top of the screen, the pop menu will show. Then click the Paste command button. The files will be copied to the images folder.








Step 6: Exit the Explorer app and go to the launcher screen. Run the Slide Show app to display the media files


Step 8: Select Play and your slide show will begin playing







Step 2: Click home button and go to the NAND FLASH menu you will see the MediaFolder open it












- 3. Choose the degree you would like to Rotate screen, then click "Confirm", after the restart, the screen will be rotated (Fig. 3)









Fig. 1 Fig. 2 Fig. 3

### **Choose System Language:**

- 1. Get into Settings, then click "Language & input" (Fig. 1)
- 2. Click "Language", then you can choose the system language accordingly (Fig. 2)



### **How to Use Password Lock**

#### Overview of Password Lock Function:

- 1. Light prompt function: three colors of light prompt: yellow represents alarm, red represents low voltage, green represents unlock.
- 2. Emergency door opening function: when the battery voltage is insufficient to drive the motor, external power supply can be used to supply power to the lock.
- 3. Low voltage alarm function: when the battery voltage is insufficient, there will be group sound alarm after opening the door.
- 4. Password protection: enter the wrong password three times in a row, lock yourself for one minute before entering the password again.
- 5. The user's password will be automatically restored to the factory password "1111 "after using the administrator password.
- 6. Status alert: allows a red light to flash while locked.
- 7. Reset function: restore the lock administrator code to the factory code.

### Operational Instructions for Use of Password Locks:

### Change user password:

(1) Private mode user password preset:

Private user password modification method: Press the "◄¬" button twice and the yellow light flashes → Enter the old user password → Press "◄¬" to Confirm → Enter a new administrative password → Press "◄¬" to confirm, The green light goes on one more time, After hearing the "beep" twice, the new user password has been changed successfully.

(2) Public mode user password modification:

Same as what is located on the front of the locker:

### To Charge & Lock:

- 1) Plug in your device inside available locker
- 2) Press [C]
- 3) Enter a unique 4-digit code and press "←¬"
- 4) Green light will flash to confirm
- 5) Close the door

#### To Unlock & Retrieve

- 1) Press [C], enter your 4 -digit code and press "←-"
- 2) Green light will flash and door will open
- 3) Unplug and retrieve your device
- 4) If wrong code is entered, orange light will flash
- 5) After 3 unsuccessful attempts, lock is disabled for 1 minute
