

CLEAN AND DISINFECT

WHITEBOARD, THERMOPLASTIC, & ACRYLIC SURFACES

RECOMMENDATIONS:

To prevent the spread of viruses and bacteria, clean surfaces at a minimum between shifts, but ideally multiple times throughout the day.

Microfiber cloths are recommended to avoid scratching the surface. Studies have shown that microfiber can eliminate bacteria and microbes on surfaces. Never use a paper towel or other abrasive cleaning cloths as they can scratch the surface.

Ghent products are manufactured to be easily cleaned and disinfected. Surfaces and materials were specifically chosen to adhere to BIFMA's guidelines for performance as it relates to typical cleaners, disinfectants, and cleaning methods for cleaning and maintenance.

To minimize the risk of damage, use only compatible cleaners and cleaning procedures. **Never use ammonia-based cleaners like glass cleaners as they will yellow the surface and leave a film behind.**

CLEANING

Before disinfecting, it is recommended to clean the surface using warm, soapy water to remove any debris. Wipe the surface lightly with the soapy water. Using the dry side of the cloth, wipe away any moisture. Allow the surface to completely dry before disinfecting.

DISINFECTING

After the surface has been cleaned, use a disinfectant wipe to sanitize the surfaces. Approved disinfectants include:

- Pharmacy grade hydrogen peroxide
- Isopropyl alcohol
- Household grade bleach diluted per CDC recommendations

And other cleaners containing these disinfectants.
