Type in a name for this rule – in the example above "FTP for Android" and click "Finish."

That completes the Inbound rule. Do the same thing for an Outbound rule. You can name it the same as this one. After you are done with both rules, close the Windows Firewall.

Enabling Awesome Player for video playback

If DisplayIt!Xpress is already playing, you may need to click Esc on the keyboard several times to get to the Android desktop.

Go into Android Settings by clicking the Settings icon.

Select About Device

Click on the Build Number – after several clicks you will see a countdown indicating you are 'almost a developer.' Keep clicking until you are a developer.

Click the go back arrow at the top left corner, or the left arrow on your keyboard.

Now there is a Developer [] choice on the menu, click on it.

You will have to scroll down a long way to the Media section.

There is a setting for Enable Awesome Player. Click on it.

Turn the machine off using the power switch in the back, and back on again.
