


1. Mark the Mounting Hole Locations




Use the ceiling plate as a template to mark four hole locations on the ceiling.


2. Install the Ceiling Plate and the Plastic Bushings




3. Assemble Pipes



4. Assemble the Universal Plate




Attach connect plate to the universal plate using correct combination of screws, washers and nuts.



Assemble the universal plate and bottom pipe with connect plate. Using correct combination of screws, washers, nuts and iron knob.


5. Mount on Solid Brick and Concrete Block




- When installing ceiling mounts on cinder block, verify the actual concrete thickness is at least 1-3/8" (35mm) for using the concrete anchors. Do not drill into mortar joints! Be sure to mount in a solid part of the block, generally 1" (25mm) minimum from the side of the block. It is suggested electric drill on slow setting be used to drill the hole instead of a hammer drill to avoid breaking out the back of the hole when entering a void or cavity.
- Installers must verify that the supporting surface will safely support the combined load of the
 equipment and all attached hardware and components.

6-2 For Recessed Back Screen or to Access A/V Inputs




Note: Choose appropriate screws, washers and spacers (if necessary) according to the type of screen.


- Position the adapter brackets as close as possible to the center of the display
- · Screw the adapter brackets onto the display.



Tighten all screws but do not over tighten.



7. Hang TV onto the Universal Plate Ó 0 1 0 Attach the TV onto the universal plate and tighten the safely screws with a proper screwdriver. Make sure the TV is safely secured before releasing.



- Check that the bracket is secure and safe to use at regular intervals(at least every three months).
