
1. Install (6) pointed feet (E) into the base (U) from the bottom.




2. Align tapped holes in the extrustion (I) with pre-drilled holes in the base (U), with an end plate (D) in between these 2 parts. Secure the extrusion by using (4) screws (A), (4) washers (B) and (4) rubber washers (R). See part numbers shown below. A second person may be



3. Assemble both supporting brackets (G) and (H) with center bracket (F) by using hex key (J). Slide the T-nut (K) down the T-slot from the top of the extrusion (I). Align corresponding holes on both parts, and affix the assembled shelf bracket securely to the desired height with (2) screws (L).



4. Attach the square plate (O) to the top of the extrusion (I) with (1) end plate (D) in the middle by fastening (4) screws (L) and (4) washers (N).




5. Assemble TV plate (P) with the square plate mounted in Step 4 by using Part (S), (N), (R) and (Q), (4) of each.



6. Slide adapter brackets (T) and (T1) from left and right respectively. See the picture below.



7. Carefully place the glass shelf (V) onto the supporting brackets assembled in Step 3. Adjust the height as needed.



8. Safely lift the TV and attach the back of TV to the brackets (T) and (T1). Secure the brackets by tightening the screw located at the bottom of each bracket.
